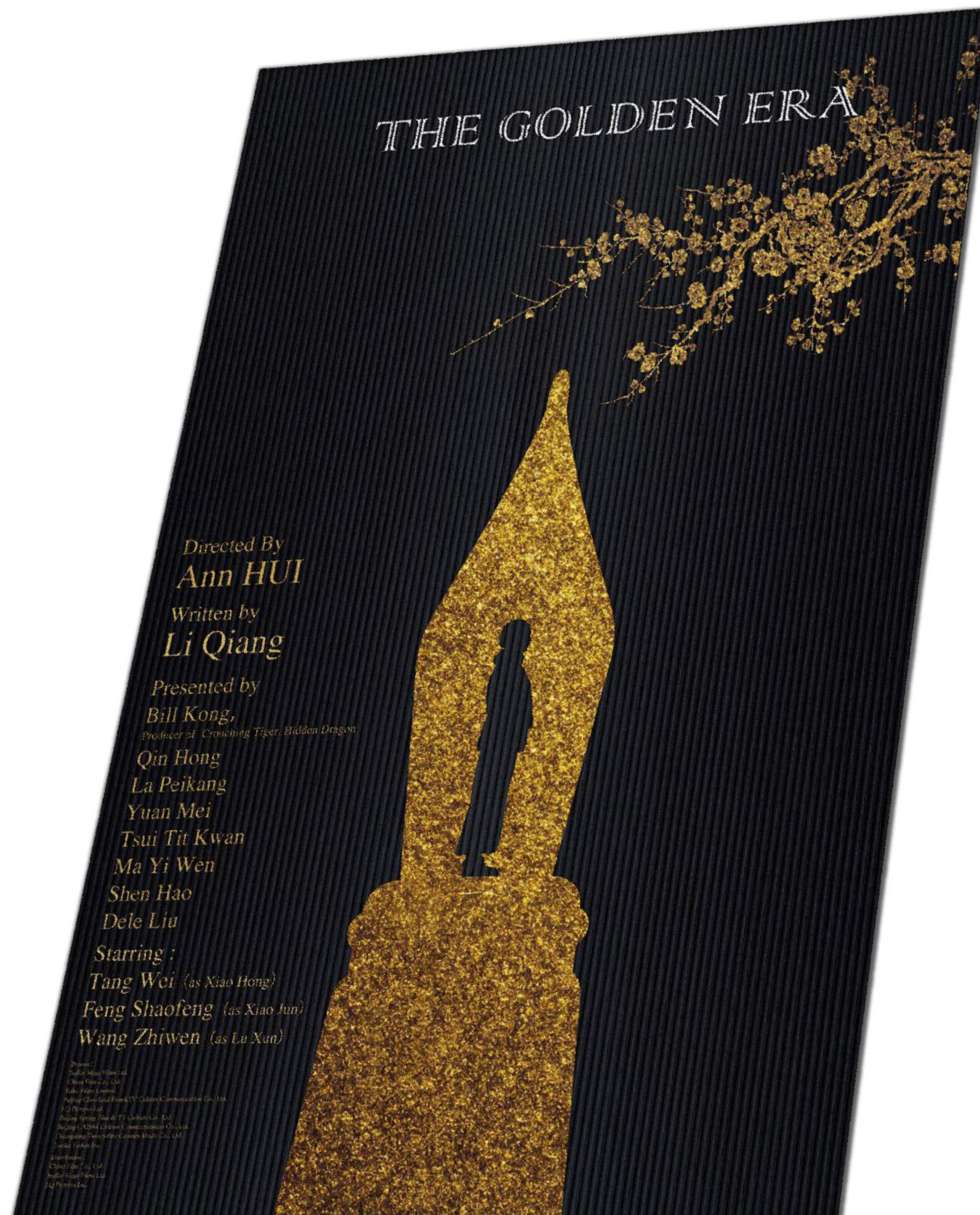

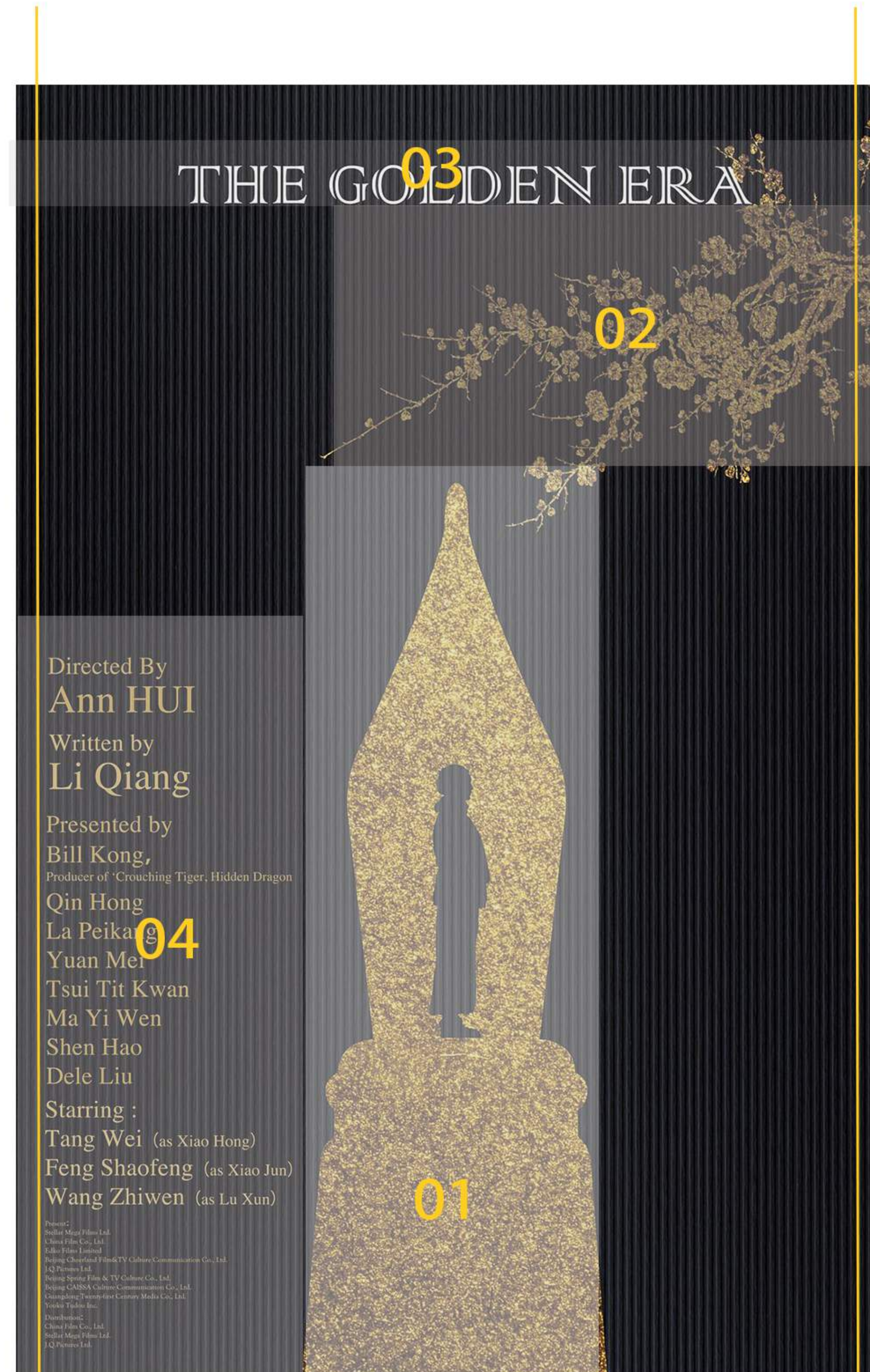


Background

Underlying Grid System



- As for poster' s layout, there is blank in the upper left corner and the lower right corner, and the left and right sides (Yellow line marks) maintain the same symmetrical edge interval, giving people a good visual balance.

- The text in area 04 is aligned to the left, with consistent segment intervals

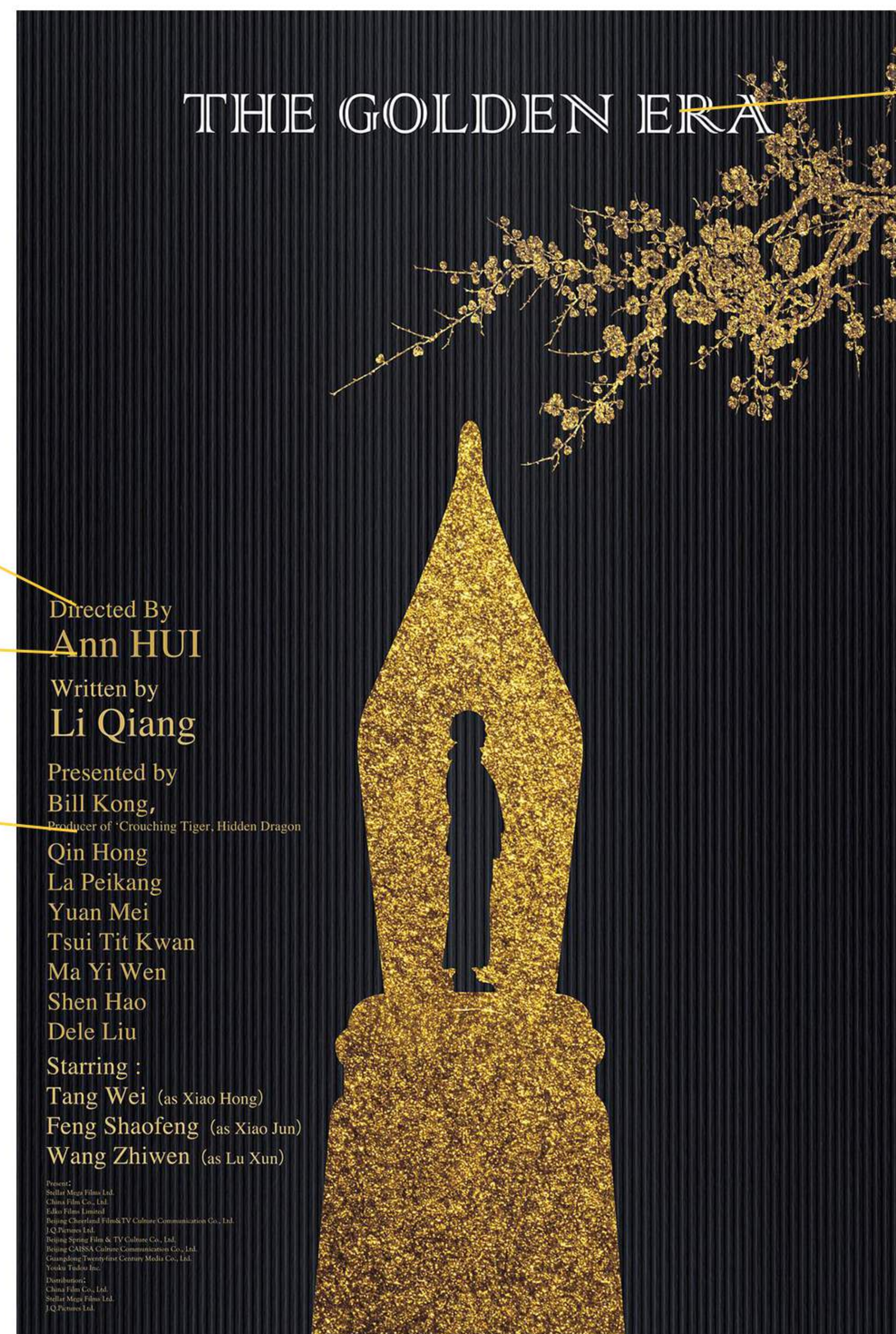

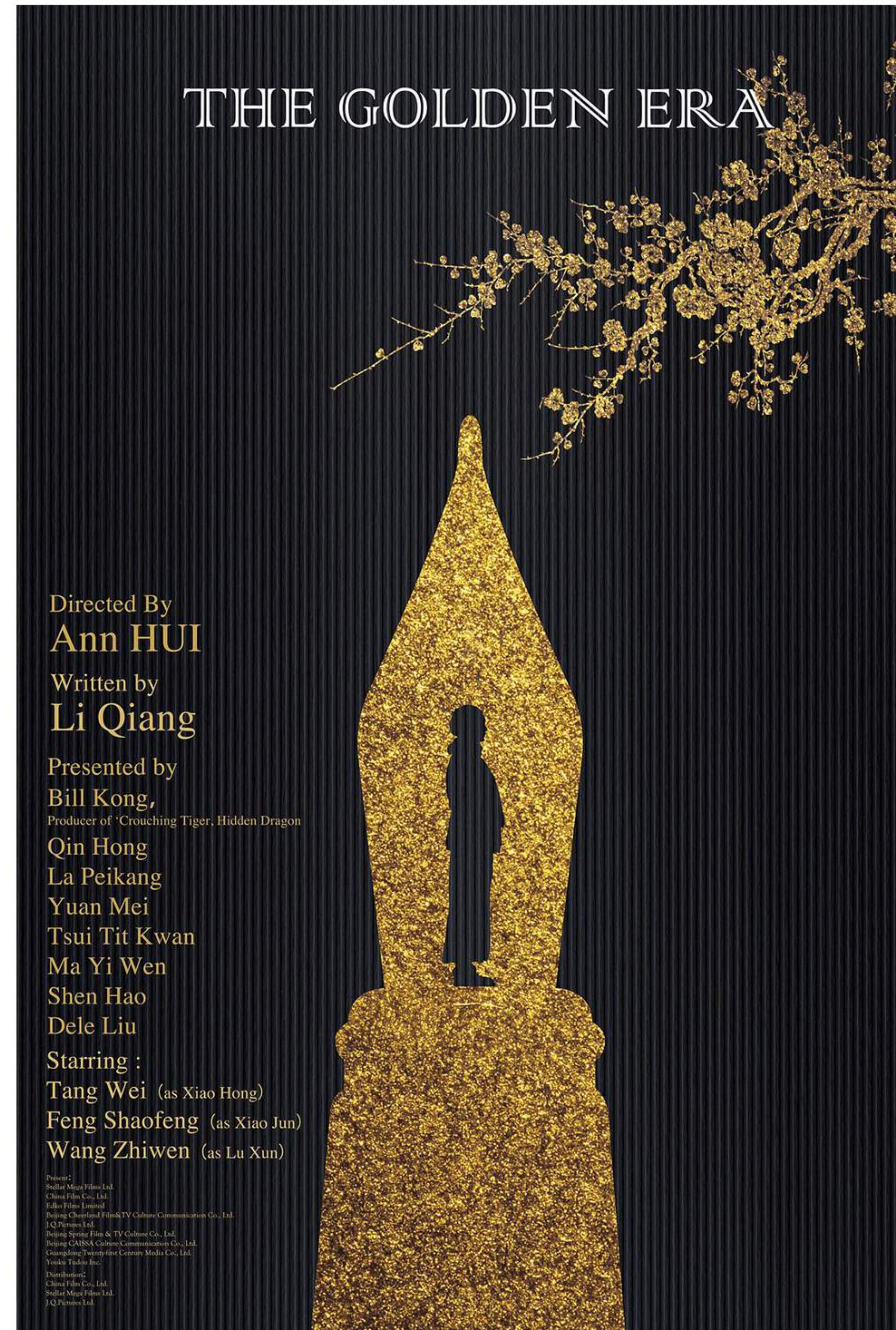

- In terms of font size, the title font is the largest, naming the movie name. Then there are the names of directors and screenwriters. Smaller fonts list actors and publishing companies. Those highlight the key points

- In terms of font type, the poster selects four main fonts. The title font has a sharp feel which is corresponding to the pen icon.



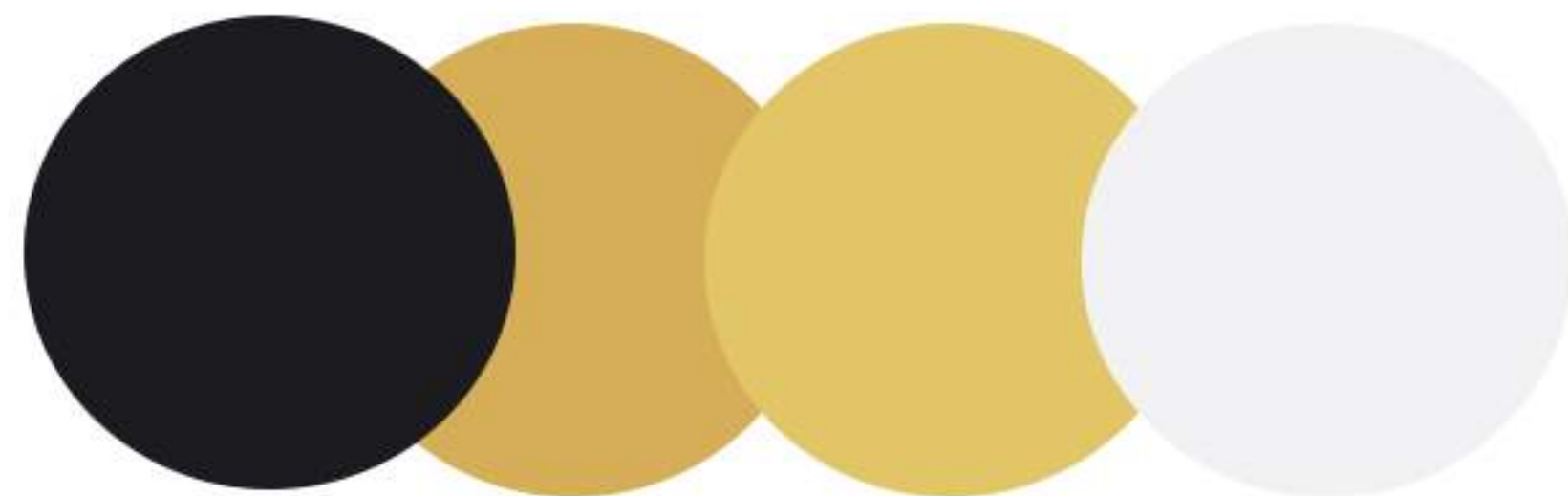
- Sharp pen Indicates that Xiao Hong(the heroine) is a writer who use writing to fight against the society. and she is very strong and unyielding. The pen with the most brightness gold in center of the poster indicate that the soul of Xiao and her deeds are rich, like the golden million. And it also corresponds with the film title.

- the figure shows that the heroine is a plain and weak women. And the skirt she wear is the style popularized in the republic of China era, showing the time period of film. The pen and the figure form a clear contrast which tell that although her body is weak, the heart is strong.

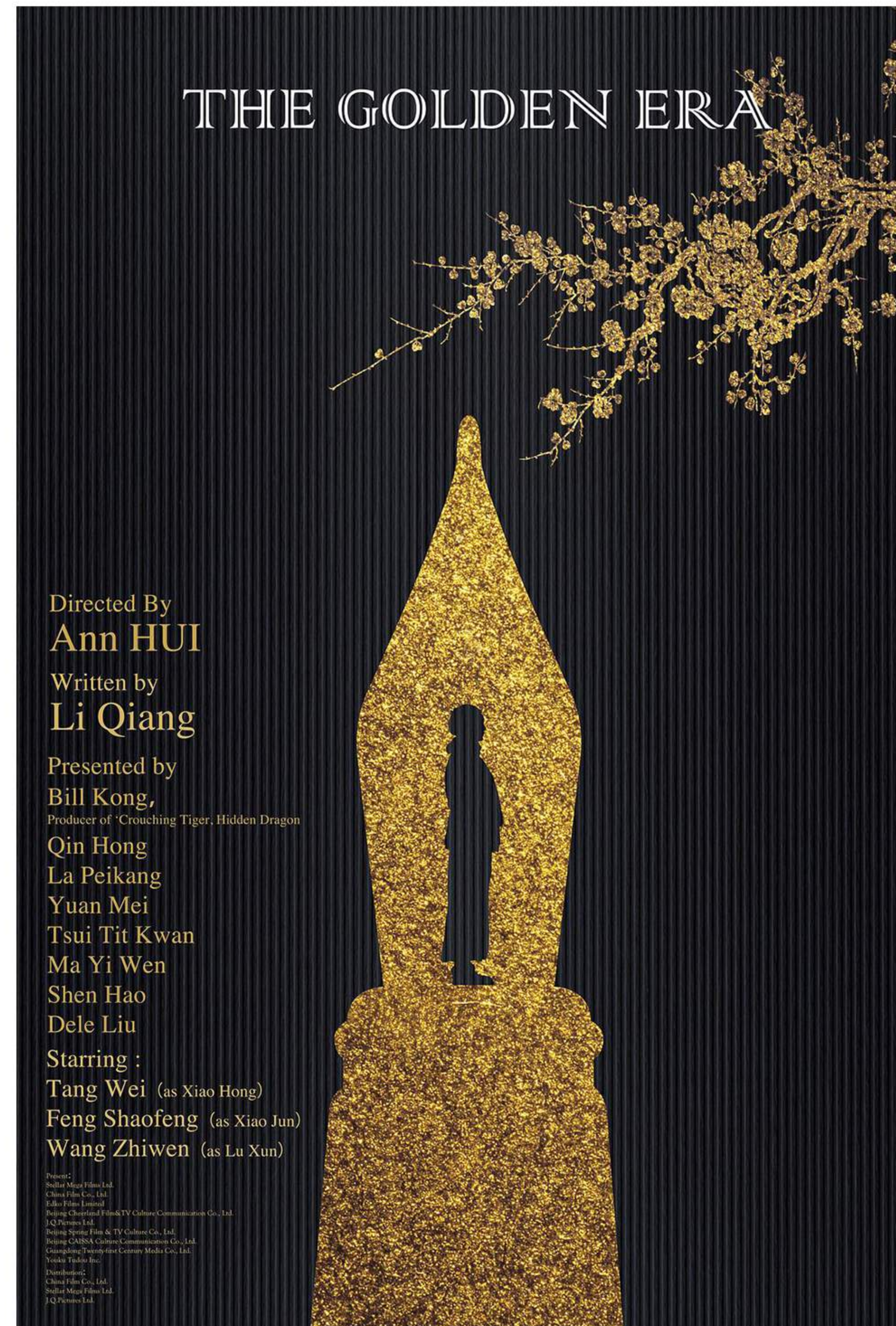
- Plum symbolics unobtainable and optimistic in China, which corresponds Xiao' qualities.
